

Agape Rehabilitation Complex

The Agape Rehabilitation Complex in Lutsk, Ukraine exists to bring people with disabilities to the knowledge of Jesus Christ through the use of three main spheres:

1. Physical rehabilitation - The primary objectives of physical rehabilitation are:

- Support and development of motor functions
- Obtaining skills for independent living
- Providing psychological support



2. Accommodation and care - The complex provides temporary and permanent residence for people with disabilities who undergo physical rehabilitation and social adaptation, or who need shelter and care in the absence of such conditions, such as when a person has lost a parent or caregiver.



3. Training center for physical therapists - The aim of the training center is to educate potential therapists from other regions of Ukraine who desire to create similar centers in their home localities. The training is conducted by experienced physical therapists through classroom education and practical training.



The territory around the Agape Rehabilitation Complex is fully accessible for power wheelchairs. Inside the complex, the halls and doorways are wide, the showers and bathrooms are wheelchair accessible, and the dining room and assembly hall are spacious. We have the capacity to house 20 patients at our complex.

While we do have some rehabilitation equipment to help our patients, we would also like to obtain a LiteGait. This specialized piece of equipment is beneficial for retraining proper gait, particularly for patients with neurological diagnoses, and it can help us increase the quality of life for many patients. Much of our current equipment was donated to us from other countries and unfortunately we cannot purchase this piece of equipment ourselves. The price of the LiteGait varies depending on the model and costs approximately \$15,000. We would be immensely grateful for a new or used one and ask any who are able to consider making a difference in the lives of people with disabilities in Ukraine, a country where resources are limited. We would be grateful to all who would consider helping us partially or fully in purchasing a LiteGait.
